# Tandem Practice

## Youth leader seminar

Welcome to Stuttgart! For us, this means to invite refugee children and young adults to participate in the leisure and educational activities in our associations. In addition, we are willing to train competent young refugees, aged 16 to 25, to become youth coaches in our associations and to support our work in children and youth groups. The training will be in German and English.

As a tandem, together with an experienced youth leader of your age, you can participate in our youth leadership training seminar. Here, both team partners will learn from each other. You will be trained to work in the association and have a chance to share your ideas about the work with children and young people from the refugee homes. In the course of training self-initiated activities with children and youth groups are encouraged. A coach will assist you during this „trial-period“.

During the consultation meeting, you can exchange information about your practical experience in the tandem. At the end of the training, a collection of ideas for a small project will be put into practice in your association.

Venue: Johanniter-Unfall-Hilfe e.V.

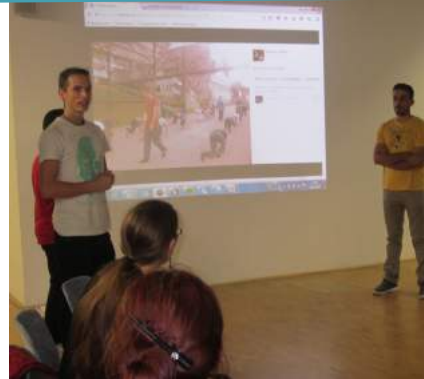

# Information and registration

In all seminars breaks and meals are included. The coaching dates in practice will be arranged with the youth representatives from Jugendwerk of AWO Württemberg and the Stadtjugendring Stuttgart. The practical sections will take place between the end of March and April 2017. A lump sum of 30 euros will be provided to each participant. Upon completion of the course modules each participant receives a Juleica card (Youth coach card) and a separate certificate.
